

SECOND ROUND OF APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIPS TO IVORY COAST

The Government of Liberia, in partnership with the French Development Agency (AFD) in Côte d'Ivoire, has made available 20 full bilateral scholarships for Liberians in the following fields: **Industrial Computer Science, Telecommunication, Computer Science, Electro-technics and Industrial Automation, Industrial Engineering, Industrial Systems Production and Maintenance, Mechatronics and Car Industry, Industrial Processing and Engineering, Bio-Process Engineering, Building and Town Planning, Road Building and Transport, Hydraulic and Environment, Topographic Surveying, Mines and Geology, Exploration Geology, Mines, Mineralogy-Foundry, Water and Mining Environment, Hydrocarbons, Water and Forest Techniques, Agro-Business, Agricultural Machinery and Rural Development, General Agriculture, Breeding and Logistics and Transport** at the "Institut National Polytechnique Felix HOUPOUET-BOIGNY of CÔTE d'IVOIRE (INP-HB) beginning 2019/2020 academic year for the duration of four (4) years.

NOTE: Students will be required to learn the French language, and studies will be conducted in French. Admission to this program is subject to passing the entrance examination that consists of (**Math, Physics, Chemistry and Logical Reasoning**), **General English and Beginner Level French**.

Applicants must:

- be a Liberian, demonstrated by the possession of a passport and birth Certificate;
- have graduated from high school in (2018 or 2019);
- have passed the **WASSCE** with very strong science marks (80 and above) in (**Math, Physics and Chemistry**);
- be not more than 24 years of age at the time of application.

Eligible candidates must forward **THREE (3) COPIES** of the following documents for consideration:

- An application form (to be picked up from the Division of Scholarships, Ministry of Education);
- An application letter by the candidate in which he/she mentions in order of prefer field of study as mentioned above, clearly stating (address, phone number and email);
- Certified photocopies of high school transcript;
- Certified photocopies of high school diploma;
- Certified photocopies of **WASSCE** Certificate;
- An **UPDATED** medical certificate issued by a recognized medical institution (**pick up the list of test**) from the Division of Scholarships;
- Six (6) recent white background (identical) passport photos in color with the full name of the candidate written at the back of each photo;

Failure to complete the application requirements and submit all documentation requested **BY THE DEADLINE** will lead to automatic disqualification. **ONLY SHORT LISTED CANDIDATES WILL BE CONTACTED.*******

Registration begins today October 2, 2019 and closes October 9, 2019 at 4.00 Pm
Entrance Exam date and venue will be announced later
